We offer five age groups: 7 and Under 10 Years, 10 and Under 12 Years, 12 and Under 14 years, 14 and Under 16 Years and 16 Years and Over. Please note there are cash prizes for the Championship winner and first and second runner-ups in each age group.

Anacortes is located on Fidalgo Island halfway between Vancouver, B.C. and Seattle, WA. Although it is a high school auditorium, Brodniak Hall, built in 1975, was designed as a professional quality theatre. Many compare it favorably with the best theatres in the state.
